Permanent Resident Visa Services (PR)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ All PR applications will be referred to one of our partner law firms. ▪ Legal fees* for outsourcing a PR application are estimated to average \$6,000. Departments will also be assessed a fee of \$400 to cover the cost of DCISS coordination and collateral services.
Temporary Worker Visa Services (H-1B)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Generally H-1B new and extension petitions will be processed by DCISS staff. ▪ Departments will be assessed a fee of \$2,000. ▪ Certain H-1B applications will be referred to one of our partner law firms. ▪ Legal fees* for outsourcing an initial H-1B application are estimated to average \$2,000. Departments will also be assessed a fee of \$400 to cover the cost of DCISS coordination and collateral services.
Outstanding Worker Visa Services (O)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ All O applications will be referred to one of our partner law firms. ▪ Legal fees* for outsourcing an O application are estimated to average \$3,000. Departments will also be assessed a fee of \$400 to cover the cost of DCISS coordination and collateral services.
Trade NAFTA Visa Services (TN)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Generally TN new and extension petitions will be processed by DCISS staff. ▪ Departments will be assessed a fee of \$620. ▪ Certain TN applications will be referred to one of our partner law firms. ▪ Legal fees* for outsourcing a TN application are estimated to average \$1500. Departments will also be assessed a fee of \$400 to cover the cost of DCISS coordination and collateral services.
Student and Exchange Visitor Visa Services (F-1 and J-1)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ All F-1 and J-1 visa services are provided by DCISS staff. ▪ Non-general campus units (e.g., Medical Center, UNEX, UCOP, UC Press, UC Merced, Self supporting programs, non-degree students, and professional schools with no 19900/20000 funds) will be assessed a fee of \$300 for F-1 and J-1 visa services.** ▪ F-1 and J-1 visa services for UCLA general campus departments and programs fully supported by 19900/20000 funds will be subsidized.
SEVIS Services for Students and Exchange Visitors (F-1 and J-1)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ In addition to any applicable J-1 visa service fees (see above), all departments with J-1 exchange visitors will be assessed a SEVIS User Fee of \$40 per year for each J-1 visitor. ▪ All departments with students on F-1 status will be assessed a SEVIS User Fee of \$40 per year for each student. ▪ These fees will offset the operating costs of the federally mandated SEVIS (Student and Exchange Visitor Information System) reporting system.

All fees are non-refundable. Applicants who are unable to secure a visa stamp for any reason will not be eligible for a refund.

* Note: Estimated legal fees do not include related expenses, or fees for visa service for dependents.

Fund Range Limitations for \$300 Visa Services Fee

The \$300 visa processing fee cannot be paid with an FAU that includes a **fund range of 21000-33999**. In addition, Contract and Grant (C&G) funds cannot be used if the funding source involves a federal agency. The fund range for C&G funds are provided on the chart below.
