The Dashew Center is preparing to launch the **MyBruin International portal**. Implementation of the portal will take place from **July 2 through July 22, 2024**, with the official launch scheduled for Tuesday, July 23, 2024. As previously announced, this new centralized portal will streamline all F-1/J-1 international student & scholar document requests at UCLA. We would like to remind students, scholars and departments that the deadline to submit requests to the Dashew Center is **Monday, July 1, by at 5pm (PT)**.
